The project

NFDI4Microbiota is a consortium that aims to support researchers in microbiology (including bacteriology, virology, protistology, mycology and parasitology) to translate research data easily into a deep understanding of microbial species and their interactions. The mission of the consortium is to be the central hub in Germany for supporting the microbiology community with access to data, analysis services, data/metadata standards and training.

Job description

You will work within the Functional Microbiome Research group at the Institute of Medical Microbiology. Your task is to coordinate the project locally within the group and be a very important communication link to the consortium and all its stakeholders. A specific task will be to coordinate the work with Use Cases within the consortium, including interactions with many institutions and researchers throughout Germany. You will also build an important bridge to the IT Center at the RWTH to coordinate all aspects of the work dealing with data management.

You hold a Master degree (or equivalent) in Science. Candidates with a PhD degree will also be considered. Education and/or experience in any of the following fields will be advantageous: informatics, data science, microbiology, project management.
