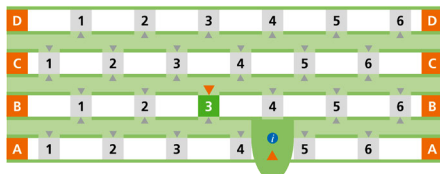

Range of investigations

Endoscopy

- › Endoscopy of the upper digestive tract ("gastroscopy")
- › Small intestine diagnostics (e.g. capsule endoscopy, balloon enteroscopy)
- › Endoscopy of the lower digestive tract ("colonoscopy" including artificial intelligence)
- › Endoscopy of the liver, bile ducts and pancreas (e.g. endosonography, ERCP)
- › All interventions on the entire digestive tract (e.g. removal of polyps, removal of tumours/cancer, dilation, cutting of excess muscle, bleeding prophylaxis, stent placement, Botox injections, endoscopic suturing, endoscopic reflux therapy, endoscopic stomach reduction)

Ultrasound

- › Abdominal ultrasound (including elastography)
- › Contrast agent examinations (via the skin or via endoscope)
- › Sonographic interventions (e.g. organ punctures, drainage via the skin)

Functional diagnostics

- › Pressure measurement of the oesophagus (manometry)
- › 24-hour pH measurement of the oesophagus
